

**IMMUNIZATIONS REQUIRED FOR SCHOOL REGISTRATION OR ATTENDANCE  
BY GRADE LEVEL FOR PARENTS AND SCHOOL STAFF  
2008-2009**

Immunizations required for school attendance are listed below for specific grade levels.

**PRESCHOOL STUDENTS** (Refer to Immunization schedule chart for Birth to 3)

- 4 DTaP
- 3 IPV (Polio)
- 1 Hib if given on or after 15 months of age
- \* 1 MMR received on or after the 1<sup>st</sup> birthday
- \*\* 3 Hep B (given at the recommended intervals)
- \* 1 Varicella (Chickenpox) received on or after the 1<sup>st</sup> birthday OR signed verification of disease from health care provider.

**KINDERGARTEN STUDENTS**

- 4 DTaP if the last dose given on or after the age of four years
- 3 IPV (Polio) if last dose is given on or after age four OR 4 doses, if all are given *before* age four
- \* 2 MMR received at or after one year of age and at least 28 days apart
- \*\* 3 Hep B (given at the recommended intervals)

**NEW** \* 2 Varicella (Chickenpox) received on or after the 1<sup>st</sup> birthday and at least 28 days apart OR signed verification of disease from health care provider.

**FIRST AND SECOND GRADE STUDENTS**

- 3 DTaP if the last dose given on or after the age of four years (Td recommended if 7 or older)
- 3 IPV (Polio) if last dose is given on or after age four OR 4 doses, if all are given *before* age four
- \* 2 MMR received at or after one year of age (at least 28 days apart)
- \*\* 3 Hep B (given at the recommended intervals)
- \* 1 Varicella (Chickenpox) given on or after the 1<sup>st</sup> birthday OR approximate age or date of chickenpox disease is acceptable

**THIRD THROUGH FIFTH GRADE STUDENTS**

- 3 DTaP if the last dose given on or after the age of four years (Td recommended if 7 or older)
- 3 IPV (Polio) if last dose is given on or after age four OR 4 doses, if all are given *before* age four
- \* 2 MMR received at or after one year of age (at least 28 days apart)
- \*\* 3 Hep B (given at the recommended intervals)

**SIXTH GRADE STUDENTS**

- 3 DTaP if the last dose given on or after the age of four years
- 1 Tdap if it has been 5 years or more since last tetanus containing vaccine and student is 11 years or older
- 3 IPV (Polio) if last dose is given on or after age four OR 4 doses, if all are given *before* age four
- \* 2 MMR received at or after one year of age (at least 28 days apart)
- \*\* 3 Hep B (given at the recommended intervals)
- \* 1 Varicella (Chickenpox) given on or after the 1<sup>st</sup> birthday OR approximate age or date of chickenpox disease is acceptable

**SEVENTH GRADE STUDENTS**

- 3 DTaP if the last dose given on or after the age of four years (Td recommended if 7 or older)
- 1 Tdap if it has been 5 years or more since last tetanus containing vaccine and student is 11 years or older
- 3 IPV (Polio) if last dose is given on or after age four OR 4 doses, if all are given *before* age four
- \* 2 MMR received at or after one year of age (at least 28 days apart)
- \*\* 3 Hep B (given at the recommended intervals)

**EIGHTH THROUGH ELEVENTH GRADE STUDENTS**

- 3 DTaP if the last dose given on or after the age of four years (Tdap may substitute for 1 of the 3 doses)
- 3 IPV (Polio) if last dose is given on or after age four OR 4 doses, if all are given *before* age four
- 2 MMR received at or after one year of age (at least 28 days apart)
- \*\* 3 Hep B (given at the recommended intervals)

**TWELFTH GRADE STUDENTS**

- 3 DTaP if the last dose given on or after the age of four years (Tdap may substitute for 1 of the 3 doses)
- 3 IPV (Polio) if last dose is given *after* age four OR 4 doses, if all are given *before* age four
- 2 MMR received at or after one year of age (at least 28 days apart)

**Please keep your own records of your child's immunizations. It is likely you will need to refer to these records in the future. A copy of official immunization records is frequently required for college admission and employment.**

\* Both the MMR and Varicella are considered "live" vaccines and therefore both vaccines must be given on the same day OR at least 28 days before or after each other. Note: Four day grace period applies to all vaccines except 2<sup>nd</sup> MMR or Varicella.

\*\* Recommended Hepatitis B intervals:

- The minimum interval between dose #1 and dose #2 is 4 weeks (24 days).
- The minimum interval between dose #2 and dose #3 is 8 weeks (52 days).
- The minimum interval between dose #1 and dose #3 is 4 months (112 days).
- The minimum age for dose #3 is 24 weeks of age (164 days)

Doses given at less than the appropriate intervals and/or age may not provide adequate protection.
