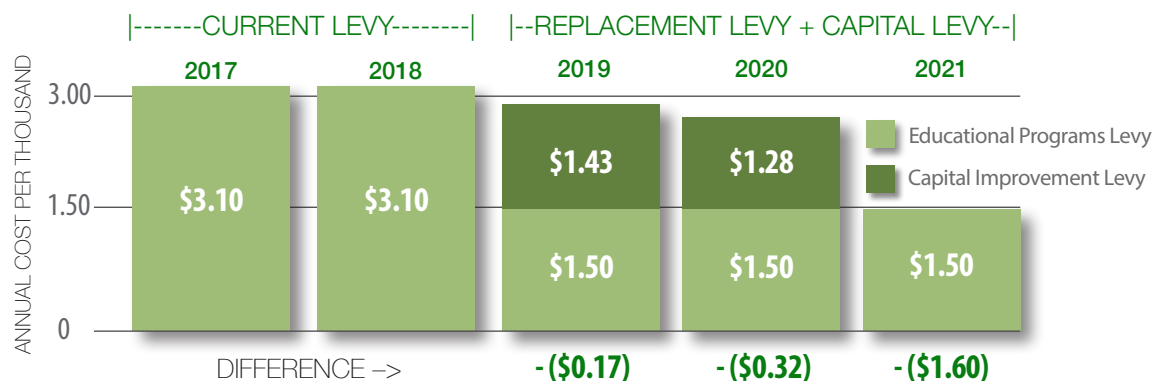
PROPOSITION 1 Replacement Educational Programs & Operations Levy

This levy is not a new tax, but a renewal (and reduction) of an existing programs and operations levy that provides over 20% of the district's annual general fund budget. The Nine Mile Falls Community has long supported our schools through the passage of these levies, which fund important educational programs and operational expenses that are not state-funded including athletics, performing arts (band, choir, drama), special education, technology, school nurses and counselors, paraeducators, after-school clubs and other extra-curricular programs. *This levy, which will provide \$2 million per year for non-state-funded educational activities, is vital to the continuance of these programs in our district.*

PROPOSITION 2 Capital Levy for Health, Safety & Energy Efficiency Improvements

Lakeside Middle School is 20 years old. Typical of a building this age, it is in need of a new roof (63,000 square feet) and replacement of the 38 rooftop HVAC units and controls, all of which are showing signs of failure. If approved, this capital levy will provide \$1.7 million per year, for two years, to fund these needed and necessary repairs. By replacing the roof, HVAC units and controls, we protect and preserve the building and mitigate future expense, which will keep the school in excellent shape for the next 20 years.
