

Non-Sufficient Funds (NSF) Check Process

The Nine Mile Falls School District is always looking for ways to be more efficient and effective in our fiscal procedures. While it may seem like a minor issue to some, receipt of non-sufficient fund (NSF) checks is a time-consuming and costly issue. As with any business, the Nine Mile Falls School District has an obligation to our clients, the community taxpayers, to be fiscally accountable. Processing NSF checks can take valuable time from school district personnel. To manage this process, the Nine Mile Falls School District uses CHECKredi to protect the interest of everyone in our school system community against the time-consuming and costly recovery of Non-Sufficient Funded checks.

CHECKredi utilizes the federal and state laws allowing the electronic recovery process of NSF checks, which results in a high rate of recovery at no cost to the school district. The cost becomes the responsibility of those who wrote the NSF check. Besides the electronic recovery of the check amount, a state-allowed recovery fee will be electronically deducted from the NSF check-writer's account. Utilizing CHECKredi is an effort by the school district to be fiscally accountable in a more efficient and cost-effective manner.

The Nine Mile Falls School District will gladly accept your checks. When you provide a check as payment, you authorize us either to use information from the check to make a one-time electronic fund transfer from your account or to process the payment as a check transaction. You authorize us to collect a fee through an electronic fund transfer from your account if your payment is returned unpaid.
